☐ High school seniors (2014 Graduate):

1. Ask your high school records office to place your transcript in a sealed envelope, stamped on the back, and include this in your materials. You may ask your high school to send an official transcript to the **Anoka-Ramsey Community College, Cambridge Campus Foundation Office, Attn: Kelly Torok-Linder, 300 Spirit River Drive S, Cambridge, MN 55008.**
2. Request your high school counselor or principal write a letter of recommendation for you.
3. If you have completed college credits through PSEO at a college other than ARCC, submit your college transcript also by making a request at that institution and having them send the official transcript to the **Anoka-Ramsey Community College, Cambridge Campus Foundation Office, Attn: Kelly Torok-Linder, 300 Spirit River Drive S, Cambridge, MN 55008.** Do not request your Anoka-Ramsey transcript.
4. Complete the Personal Information section and Applicant's Verification (white insert).
5. On separate paper, complete all sections described on the back of the application. Include your name at the top of each page and title each section. Submit all writing requirements with this completed application.

☐ Recent high school graduates (high school graduates up to and including age 20):

1. Ask your high school records office to place your transcript in a sealed envelope, stamped on the back, and include this in your materials. You may ask your high school to send an official transcript to the **Anoka-Ramsey Community College, Cambridge Campus Foundation Office, Attn: Kelly Torok-Linder, 300 Spirit River Drive S, Cambridge, MN 55008.**
2. If you have completed college credits at a college other than ARCC, submit your college transcript also by making a request at that institution and having them send the official transcript to the **Anoka-Ramsey Community College, Cambridge Campus Foundation Office, Attn: Kelly Torok-Linder, 300 Spirit River Drive, Cambridge S, MN 55008.** Do not request your Anoka-Ramsey transcript.

☐ Other applicants (age 21 and older):

1. If you have completed college credits at a college other than ARCC, submit your college transcript also by making a request at that institution and having them send the official transcript to the **Anoka-Ramsey Community College, Cambridge Campus Foundation Office, Attn: Kelly Torok-Linder, 300 Spirit River Drive S, Cambridge, MN 55008.** Do not request your Anoka-Ramsey transcript.
2. Complete the Personal Information section and Applicant's Verification (white insert).
3. On separate paper, complete all sections described on the back of the application. Include your name at the top of each page and title each section. Submit all writing requirements with this completed application.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- To apply for any scholarship, you must meet the criteria for that scholarship. Please see the list of scholarships (page 3-4).
- Students who will be participating in the Post-Secondary Enrollment Options Program (PSEO) in the coming academic year are ineligible for scholarships. **A 2014 high school graduate IS eligible.**
- Any student awarded an Anoka-Ramsey Community College Cambridge Campus scholarship must attend the Anoka-Ramsey Community College Cambridge Campus for the number of credits specified for that scholarship. On-line courses must have a location of Cambridge Campus. Full-time is always considered 12+ credits per semester unless otherwise stated. Part-time is always 6-11 credits per semester unless otherwise stated. Students will also be expected to complete their coursework and maintain the GPA specific to the awarded scholarship.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

The deadline to apply for a scholarship is **October 15** for an award to be distributed in Spring Semester 2015.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD NOTIFICATION

Scholarship applicants will be notified by mail sometime in December.

Scholarships Available

Apply by October 15, 2014

- PSEO students are not eligible to receive a scholarship while enrolled in the PSEO program.
- Recipients must be enrolled on the Cambridge Campus according to the scholarship criteria.
- Half of the scholarship award will be applied toward recipients' tuition each semester upon GPA evaluation and completion of enrollment in Cambridge Campus credits.
- An individual can receive only one Cambridge Foundation scholarship per academic year, for no more than three years.
- Recipients must complete 12 or more Cambridge Campus credits to be considered full-time, unless otherwise specified. Part-time students must complete a minimum of six Cambridge Campus credits.
- The following scholarships will be applied toward recipients' Spring 2015 tuition.

PRESIDENTIAL (\$1,500)

- Be a 2014 high school graduate
 - Graduate with a cumulative 3.0+ high school GPA
 - Maintain a cumulative 3.0 or more college GPA
 - Complete 12+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester
- (This scholarship is renewable the second year at half the value, provided criteria has been met.)*

DEAN (\$1,000)

- Be a 2014 high school graduate
 - Graduate with a cumulative 3.0+ high school GPA
 - Maintain a college cumulative 3.0 or more college GPA
 - Complete 12+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester
- (This scholarship is renewable the second year at half the value, provided criteria has been met.)*

GENERAL FOUNDATION (12+ CREDITS @ \$750) OR (6 TO 11 CREDITS @ \$500)

- Demonstrate community service in Part A of application
- Have a cumulative 2.5 GPA, if available
- Complete 12+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester for \$750 or 6-11 Cambridge Campus credits each semester for \$500
- Maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA

KOPP FAMILY FOUNDATION (\$500)

- Be out of high school at least one full academic year
- Be a resident of Cambridge Campus service area
- Have had at least a 2.5 GPA in high school or college
- Demonstrated leadership involvement in school/community
- Maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA
- Complete 12+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester for \$500 or 6-11 Cambridge Campus credits each semester for \$250 per semester

CAMBRIDGE/ISANTI ROTARY CLUB (\$500)

- Be a 2014 high school graduate from Cambridge-Isanti High School
- Have a high school 3.0 GPA or higher
- Complete 12+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester
- Maintain a 3.0 college GPA or more

EAST CENTRAL SANITATION (\$500)

- Have a 2.5 GPA or more to be considered
- Complete 12+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester
- Maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA or more

LEVIG MEMORIAL ENDOWED (\$500)

- Have a 3.0 GPA or more to be considered
- Complete 12+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester

EAST CENTRAL ENERGY (\$500)

- Be a customer of East Central Energy
- Complete 12+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester
- Maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA or more

MEMORIAL HOSPITAL (\$500)

- Must reside within the Cambridge Medical Center service area
- Must be enrolled in the Cambridge Campus Nursing Program

EGAN CHILCOTE MEMORIAL (\$500)

- Complete 6+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester
- **Submit** a letter of recommendation from either a faculty member or a retail employer that affirms the applicant's commitment to hard work and customer service
- Demonstrate a desire to work in business, especially retail
- Submit proof of excellent academic performance (performance is dominant over need)

ISLE VFW (\$375)

- Be a 2014 Isle High School graduate
- Maintain a cumulative 2.75 GPA
- Complete 6+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester

JERRY BRAMBRINK MEMORIAL (\$250)

- Complete 6+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester
- Maintain a cumulative 2.0 GPA or more

FRANSEN BANK & TRUST (\$250)

- Be a 2014 high school graduate
- Complete 12+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester
- Maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA or more
- Be a resident of Chisago, Isanti, Kanabec, or Pine counties
- **Submit an additional essay** on "What this Scholarship Would Mean to You."
- Must be Pell Grant eligible (**Verified by FAFSA status as "eligible"**)

LAKE STATE CREDIT UNION (\$250)

- Complete 12+ Cambridge Campus credits each semester
- Maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA or more
