Mobile lab delivers hands-on excitement to Minnesota schools

QUICK FACTS

- The Central Minnesota Mobile Bioscience Laboratory Program is a joint initiative of St. Cloud State University, St. Cloud Community and Technical College, Anoka-Ramsey Community College, Minneapolis Community and Technical College and Riggewater College.

- The project received a \$200,000 seed grant from the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities Bioscience Initiative in June 2008 and Medtronic donated a fully-loaded trailer in the spring of 2009

- During the school year, the lab will provide hands-on science activities to Minnesota K-12 students through scheduled visits to schools across the region,

- During the summer, the mobile lab will host summer science camps for students and professional development opportunities for teachers.

- The mobile lab provides a self-contained laboratory teaching environment that can accommodate up to 36 students, and a gifted enthusiastic instructor to bring science to life.
