Welcome to the first edition of **Advising Times!** This is a bi-weekly e-newsletter from Advising Services that discusses important information regarding your time at Anoka-Ramsey Community College!

During this first issue, Advising Services would like to bring your attention to upcoming events at the College:

- **Midterms** – As you are preparing to complete your mid-terms, make sure you are using resources available to you on campus. Consider dropping into the Academic Support Center for some extra help from our faculty-referred tutors! You can view the tutoring times here:

  - If needed, come into Advising as well to discuss options – the last day to withdraw from semester-long courses with a “W” is April 20. After April 20, you may no longer withdraw from a course unless it is a late-starting course. To find out the last day to withdraw from late-starting courses, go to the course description.
  - To find out the consequences of earning a “W” in a course, check out the SAP policy:

- Thinking about taking **summer classes?**
  - There are some differences between summer classes and full-semester classes:
    - During summer classes, everything you would learn in 16 weeks is **condensed down** to 4 or 8 weeks. That means a **three credit class will feel like a six credit class**. Consider your summer schedule and other commitments before you commit to a summer class.
  - **Registration** for summer classes begins April 4 for students with 30+ credits and April 5 for all other students!
  - Review the summer course schedule on your eServices page.
- **Fall registration** begins April 18, however the day you register is dependent on the number of credits you’ve earned at Anoka-Ramsey. To find out when you can register go to:

  - You can come into Advising (behind the Information Desk at either campus) for help with choosing courses; make sure you know your log-in information for eServices (student ID number and 8 character password containing letters, numbers and a special character). It is to your advantage to come in earlier in the month to talk with an advisor!
