Interpreting Your Results

(Anoka-Ramsey Community College)

Your scores on the placement tests at Anoka-Ramsey Community College (Cambridge or Coon Rapids) will assist you in deciding which courses are appropriate to your level of skills in reading comprehension, English and mathematics.

Students who follow the placement test recommendations and/or requirements are more likely to be successful and more likely to stay in college.

If you have questions about the accuracy of your placement, talk with a counselor/advisor on campus or refer to the retest options in this handout.

Reading Comprehension

0-27	Additional pre-college reading required (see a counselor or advisor) or build skills with ABE (Adult Basic Education: call 763-433-1940)
28-53	READ 0910 is required during your 1 st semester (You will be placed on HOLD until you register for this course)
54-77	READ 0990 (recommended)
78-120	No reading course is required/ READ 1106 or READ 1108 is optional

Note: Readiness for college level Writing/English is determined by your placement on the Reading Comprehension placement test.

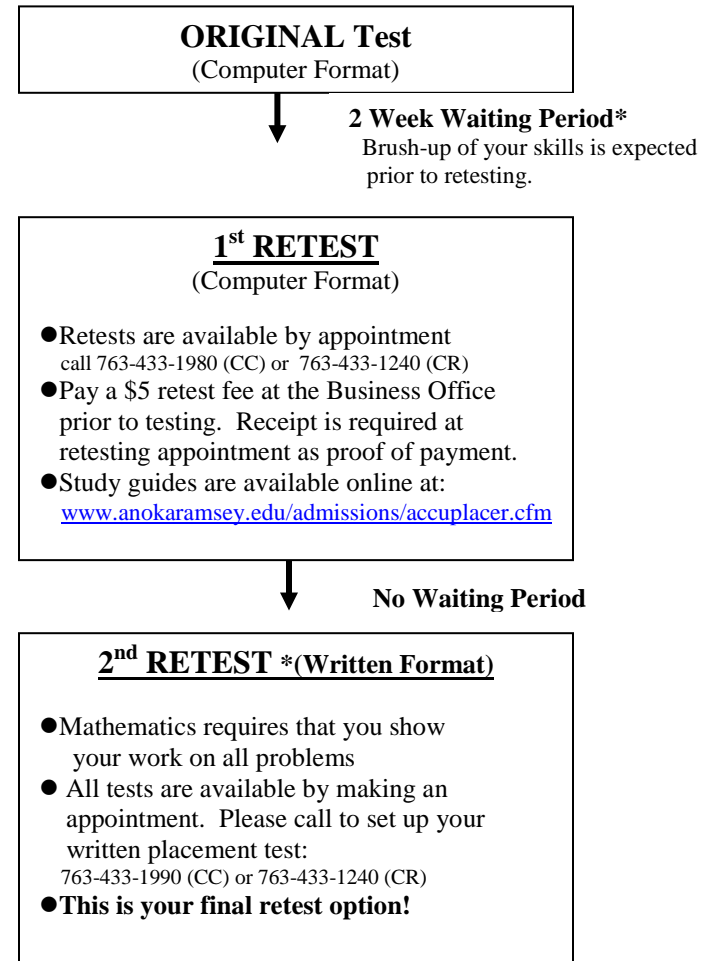

Retesting Process

If you are not satisfied with your test results and course placements, you are allowed to retest on any of the placement tests. There is a \$5.00 retest fee, payable in the Business Office prior to retesting. Your receipt is required when attending your retest session. The retest and appeal process applies only to initial course placements. (Only with an instructor’s and Dean’s written permission may a student use this process once they have started a course in the subject area).
