

**Minnesota Transfer Curriculum**

To complete the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum, all ten emphasis areas listed below must be completed. A total of at least 40 semester credits must be earned with a minimum 2.0 GPA. Courses designated with a superscript (e.g., ENGL 1121<sup>2</sup>) satisfy more than one goal area. **Note: Credits are counted only once toward the 40-credit minimum requirement.**

## **U Select (formerly MNCAS (Course Applicability System))**

**Shows course equivalencies between colleges.**

Steps:

- 1) Log onto: [www.mncas.org](http://www.mncas.org)
- 2) Select 'Guest Log-In' from left menu
- 3) Select 'Equivalencies by School' under the 'Courses' heading
- 4) Step 1- Select the college you are transferring TO
- 5) Step 2 – Select the college FROM which your coursework is coming
  - Click on the 'Region' tab
  - Select 'US States' from Type menu
  - Select the state your college credits are coming FROM (most often you will be selecting Minnesota from this menu)
  - Hit Go
- 6) Step 3- Check the box in the 'Add' column for college of choice and click on 'Add Schools' located at top of list
- 7) Step 4- Click on 'Create Guide'
