Costa Rica

Spend spring semester immersed in Spanish language and Central American life and culture. Ten days of preparatory classes followed by approximately 10 weeks at the Instituto de Cultura y Lengua Costarricense near San Jose. Earn 8 credits in Spanish and 6 credits in arts/humanities courses. Scheduling allows for extra work time in January and early out in April; financial aid may apply. Approximate cost is \$4,500 for travel, home stay with local family, program activities, laundry, insurance, and some course materials (tuition, passport, personal expenses extra). Oxford, England

Offered fall semester in cooperation with Education for Global Learning and Oriel College in England. Students stay with British families and attend classes at Oriel College in the center of Oxford. Offered for 12 credits (four courses); additional credits possible. Cost approximately \$5,500; includes airfare, transfers, private room in a British home, daily continental breakfast and dinner during home stay, three group excursions, arrival/departure events, medical and travel insurance. Zhaoqing, China

Spend a semester or a full year immersed in the Chinese language and culture. Zhaoqing University is a state-run University approved by the Ministry of Education to be set up and to offer four-year courses. Earn credits in Chinese language. Approximate cost is \$5,000 for a semester or \$7,500 for a full year, which includes airfare, transfers, food, lodging and tuition.
