Transfer Guide for METROPOLITAN STATE UNIVERSITY

Transfer Process:

1. Submit an admissions application to Metropolitan State University, and pay the \$20 non-refundable application fee.
2. Send official transcripts of all previously attended institutions (except MnSCU transcripts)
3. Apply for financial aid
4. Sign up for orientation after you receive an acceptance email/letter
5. Register for courses after you attend orientation!

Application Deadlines:

- Fall Semester: June 30
- Spring Semester: November 15
- Summer Semester: March 15

Admissions Requirements:

- Transfer students (students who completed 16 or more college level semester credits) must have an overall cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0.

Important Transfer Information:

- *How associate degrees transfer:*
 - Associate of Arts (AA) satisfies *all* of Metropolitan State's MnTC
 - Associate of Science (AS) satisfies *most* of Metropolitan State's MnTC
 - Associate of Applied Science (AAS) satisfies *some* of Metropolitan State's MnTC
 - Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) courses with "D" grades will satisfy Metropolitan State's MnTC, but will *not be acceptable for major pre-requisites or major requirements*.
 - Students transferring to Metropolitan State without an Associate of Arts degree or the MN Transfer Curriculum must complete 40 semester credits of general education requirements which address the 10 goal areas.
- Articulated programs must be completed in its entirety, and you must declare the articulated major at Metropolitan State for the Articulated Agreement to apply.
- Some majors have specific course requirements or pre-requisite requirements that must be completed before admission to that major. The Metropolitan State website will give you this information.
